

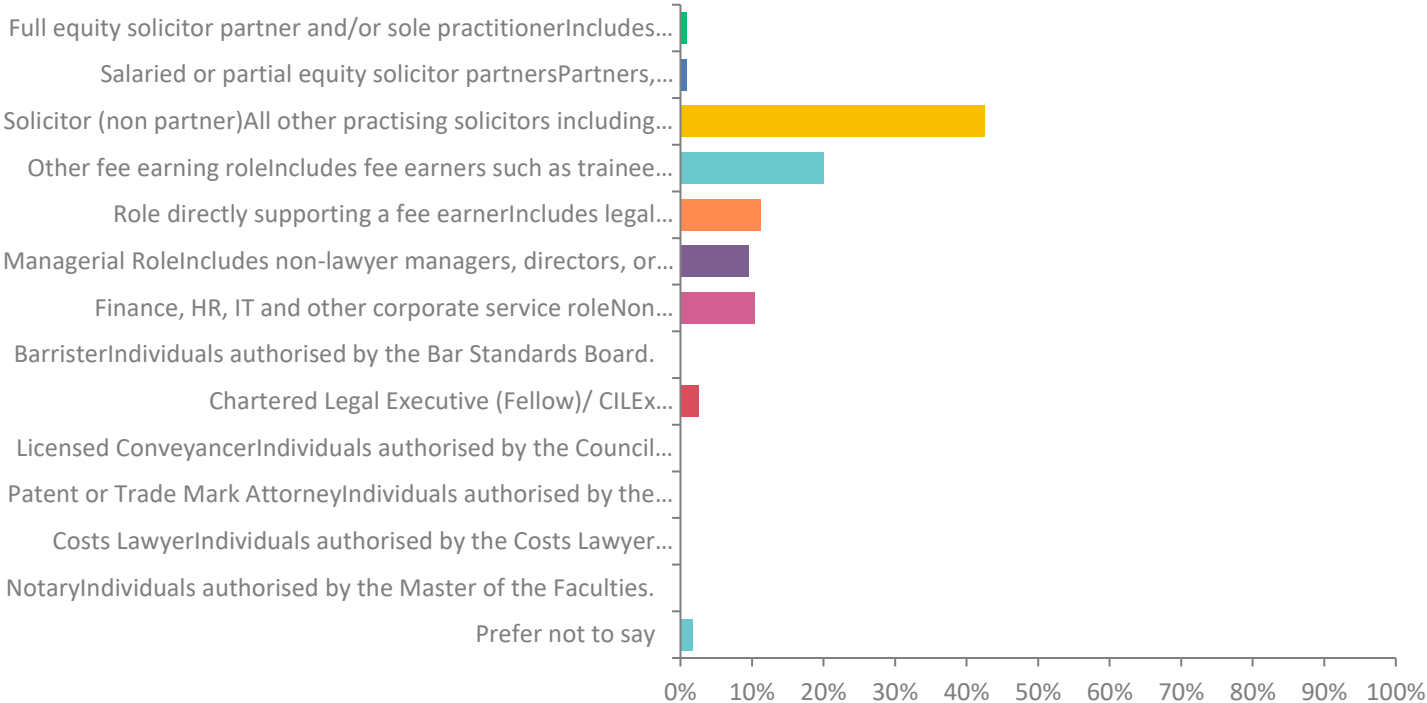

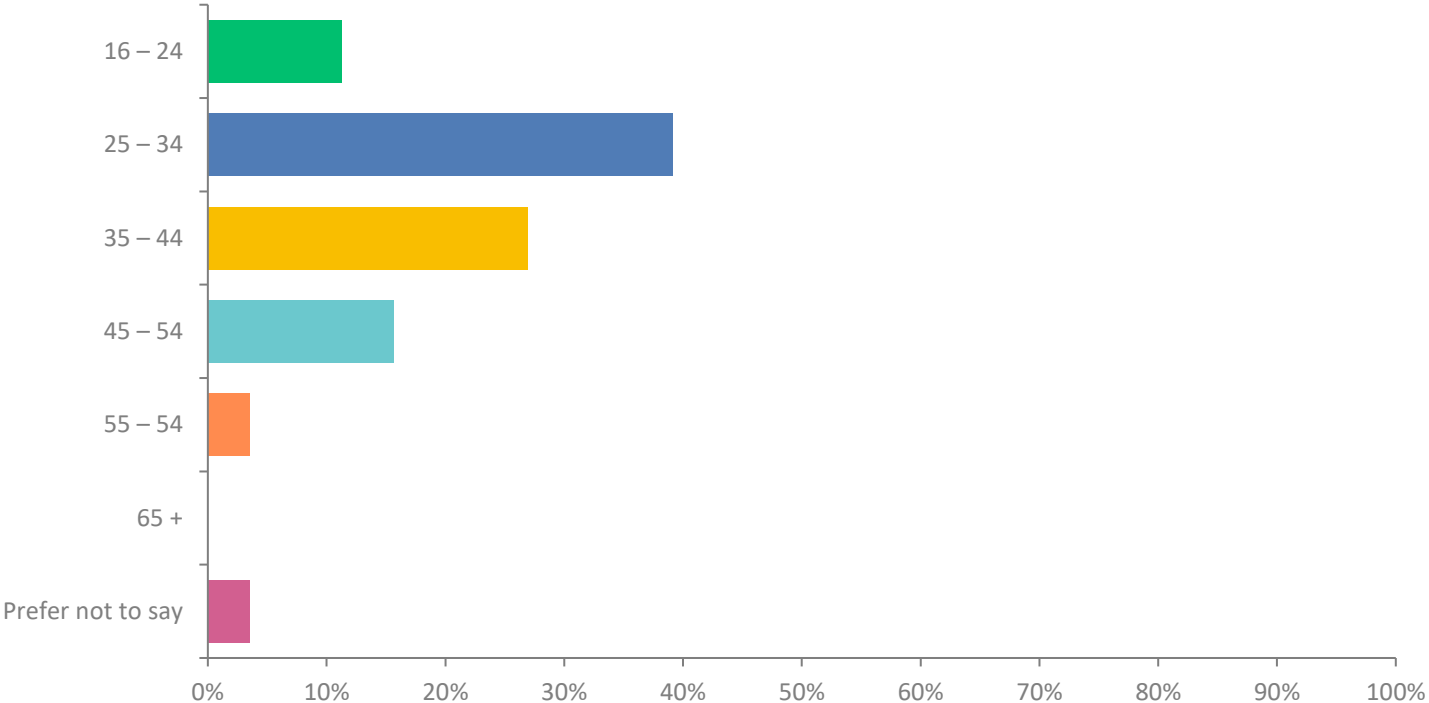
Q1: Which best describes your role within the Firm?

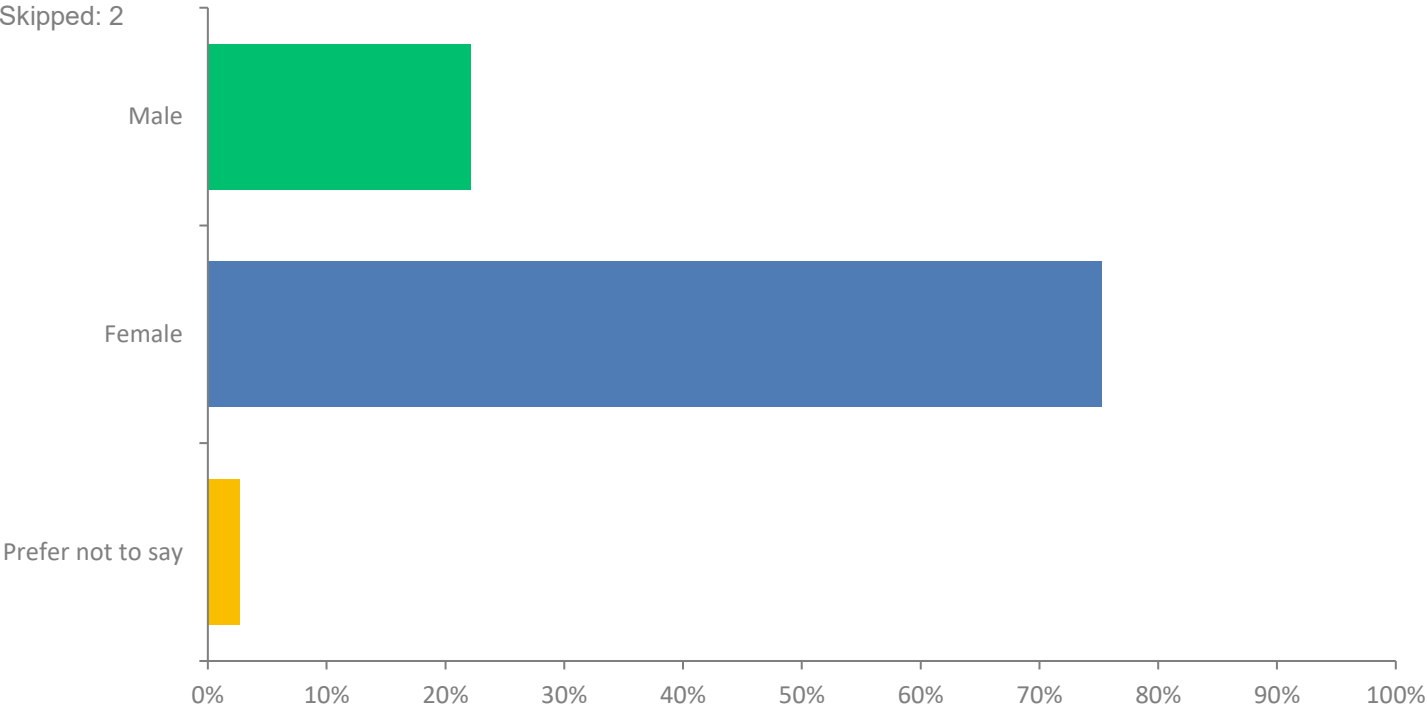
Q2: Which age category are you in?

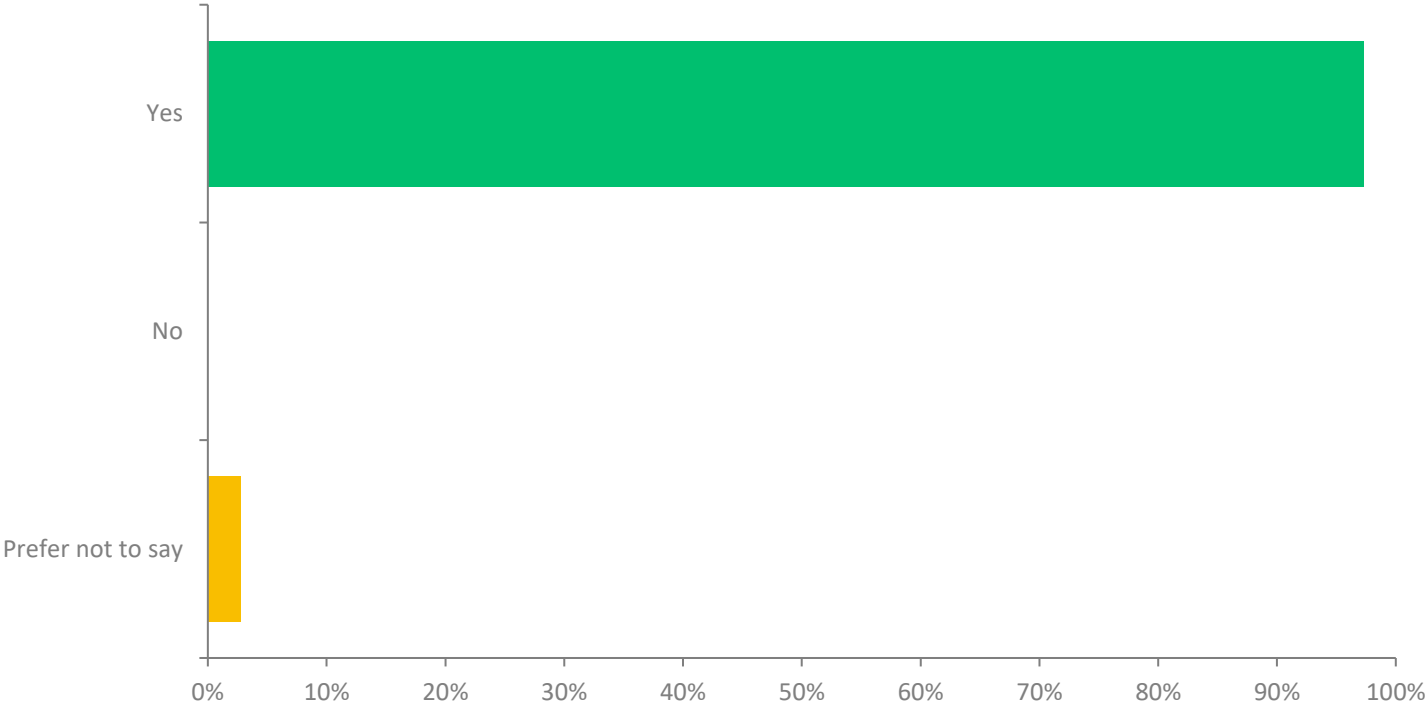

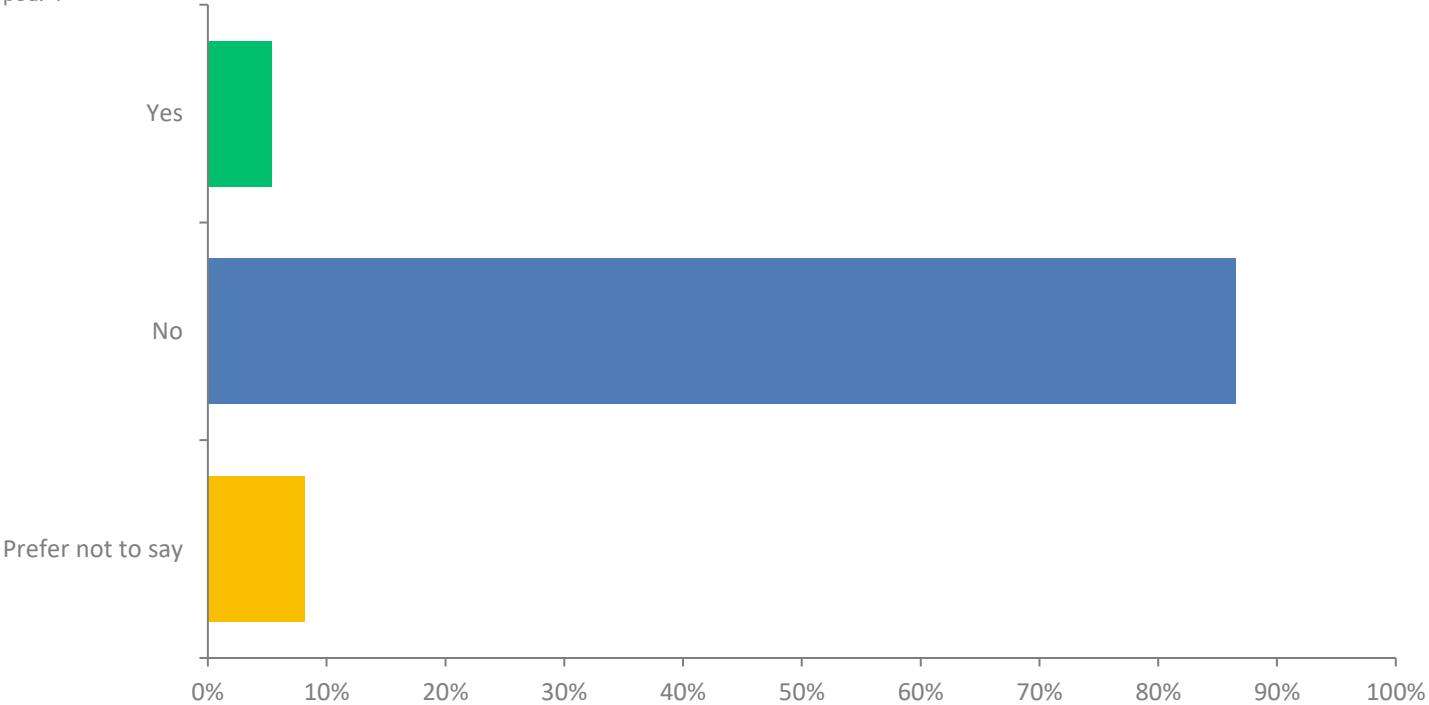

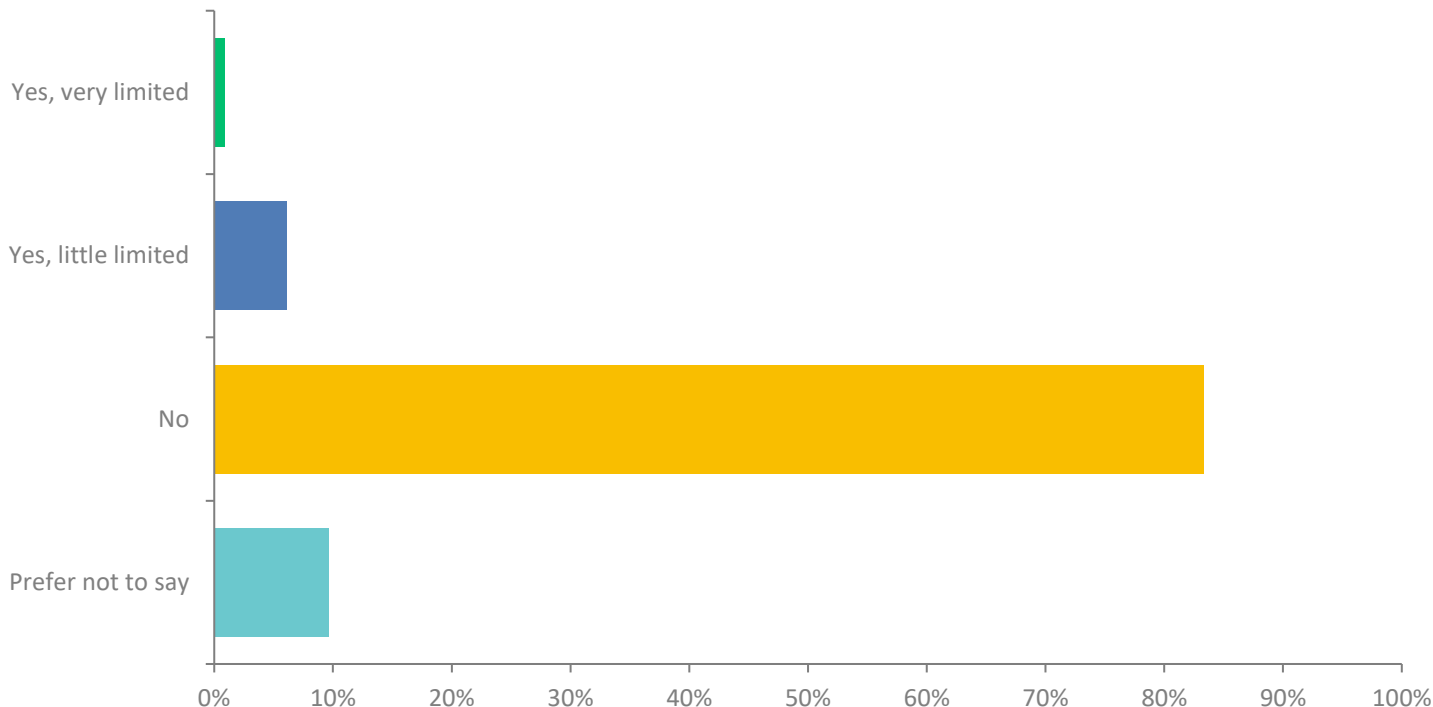

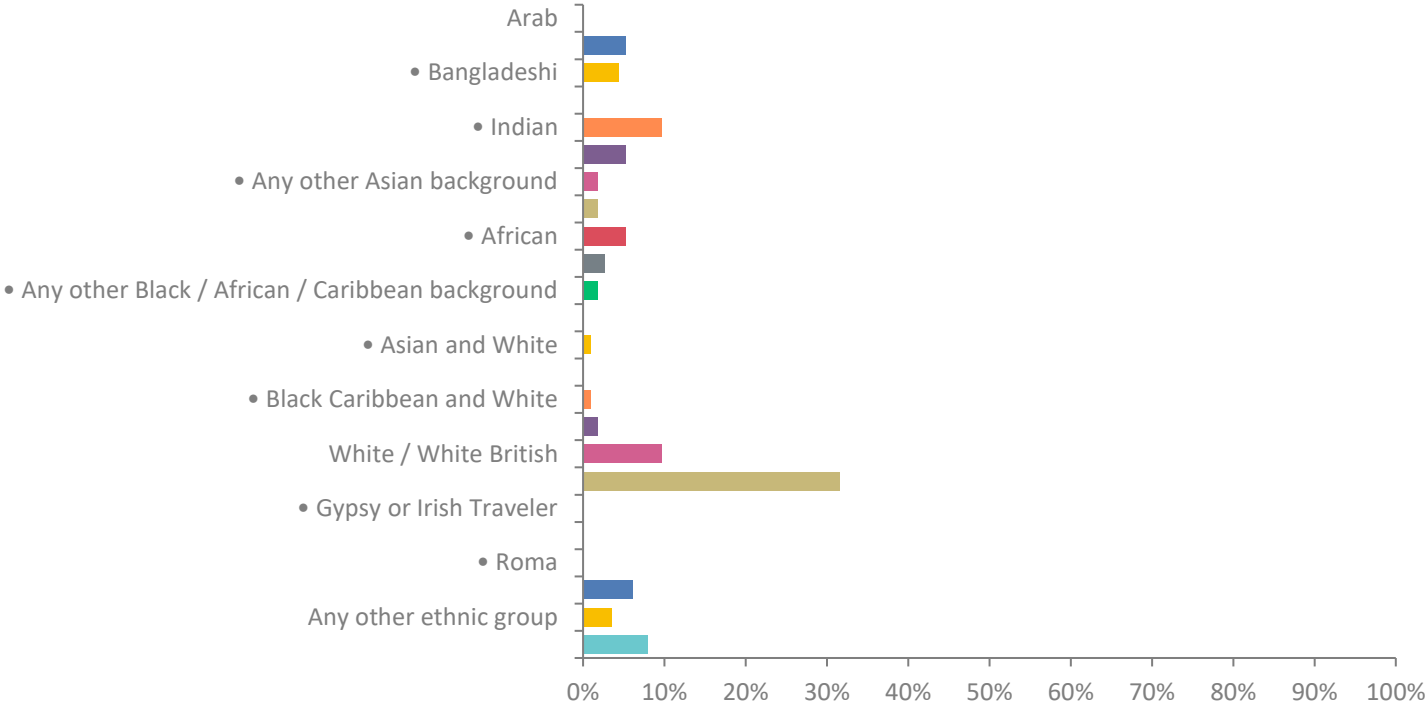

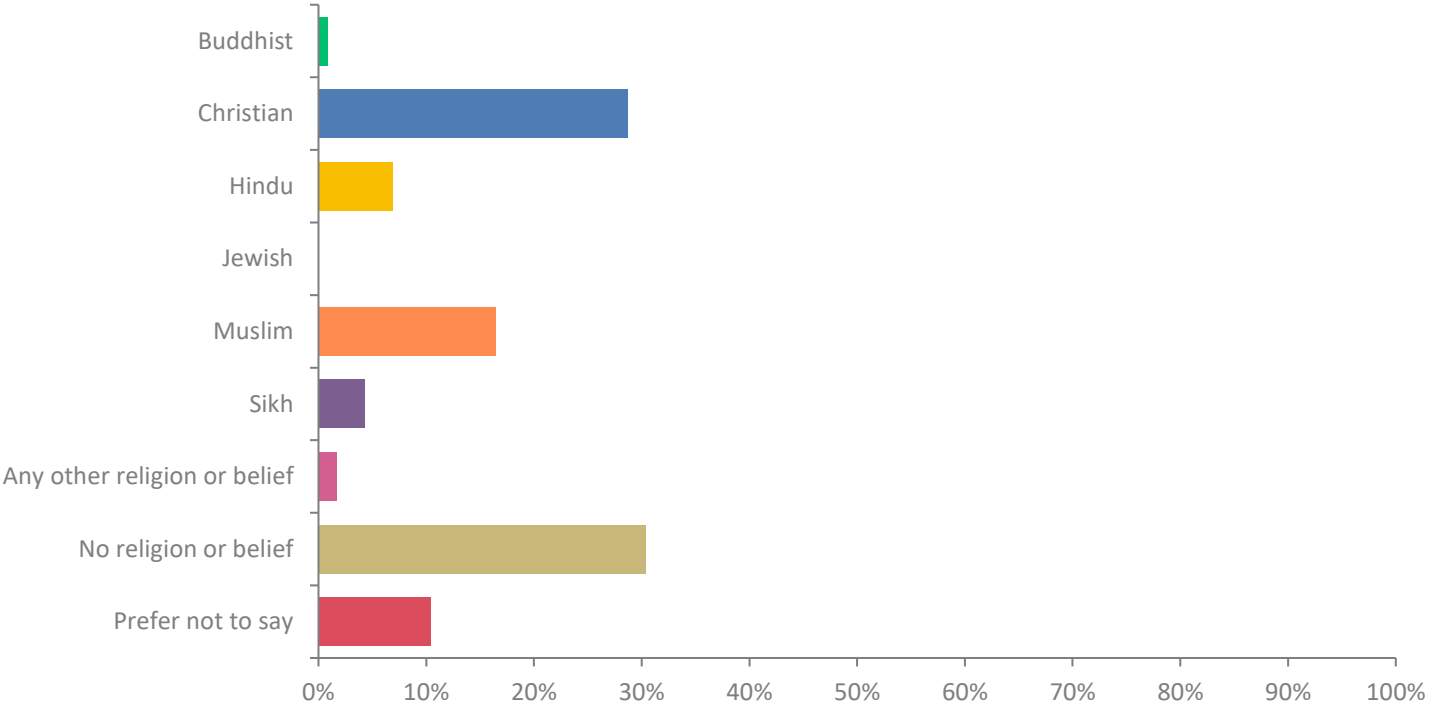

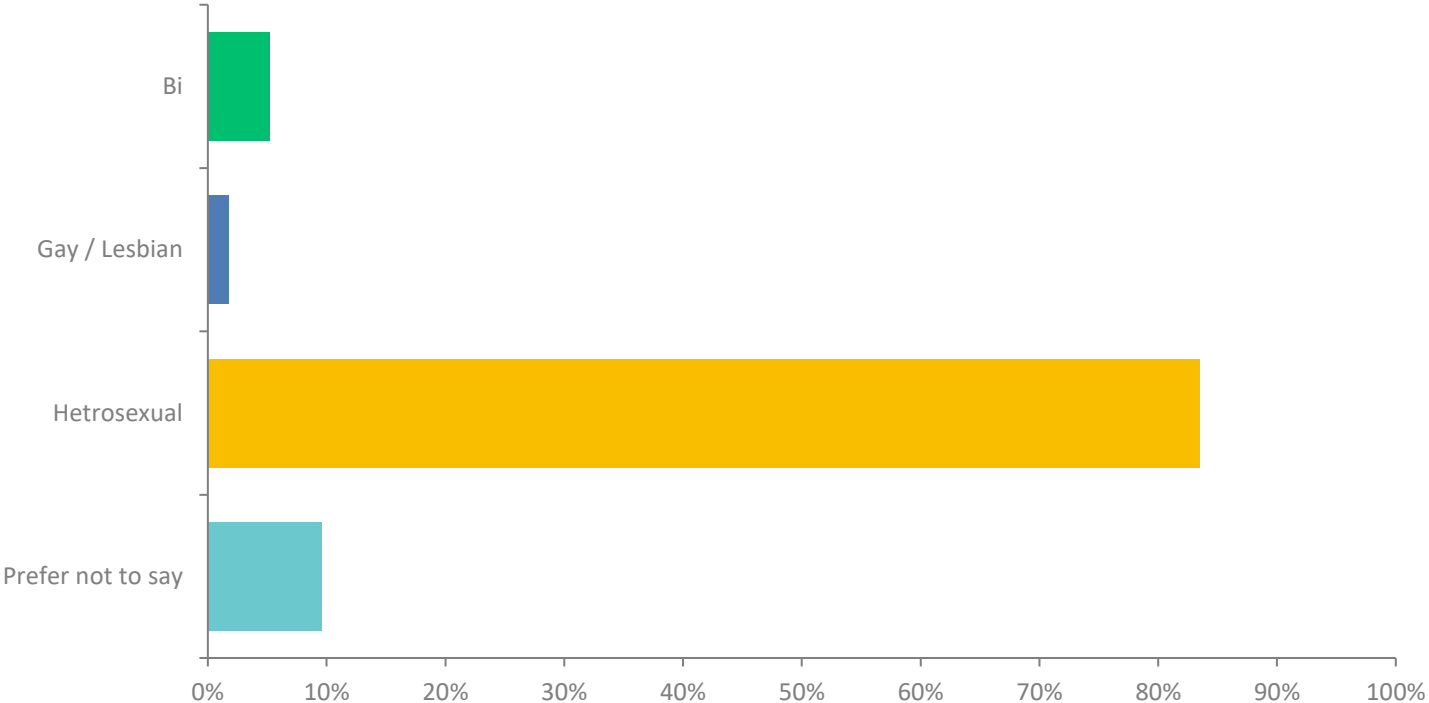

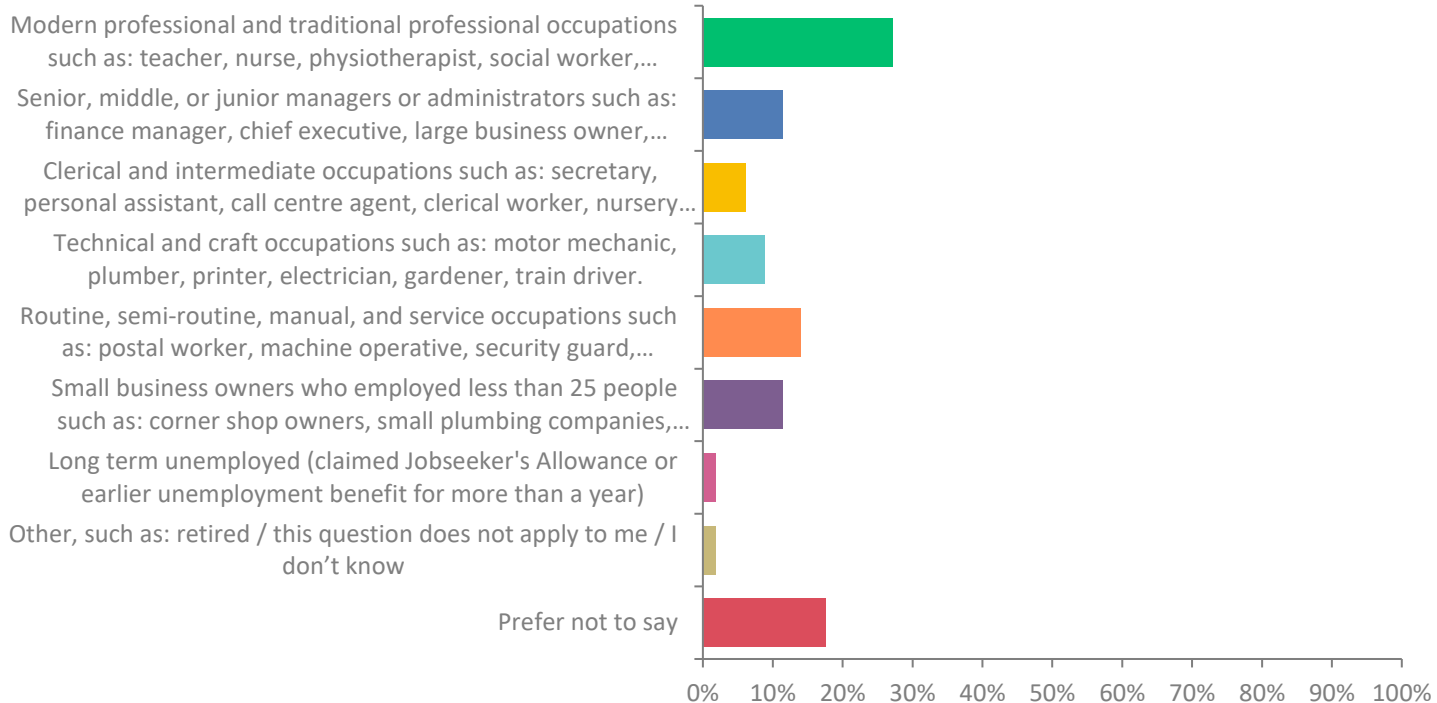

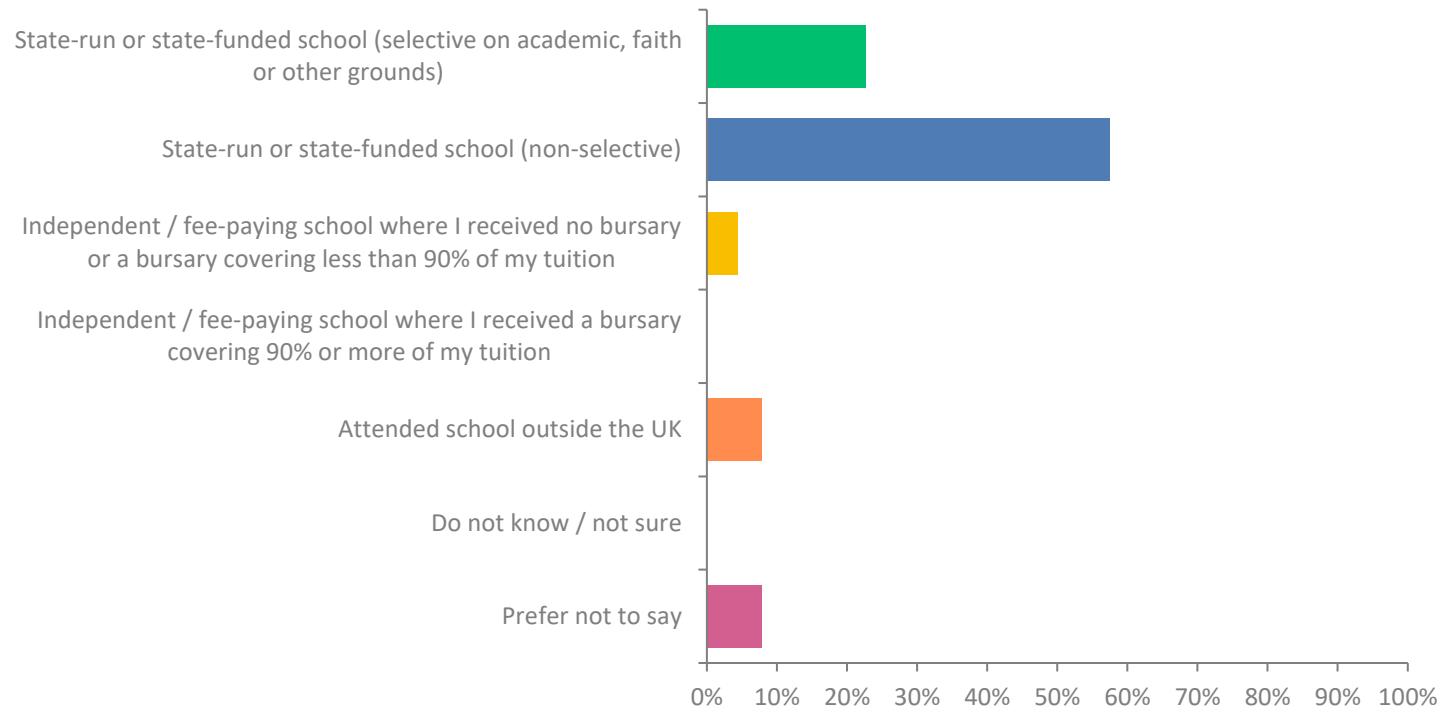

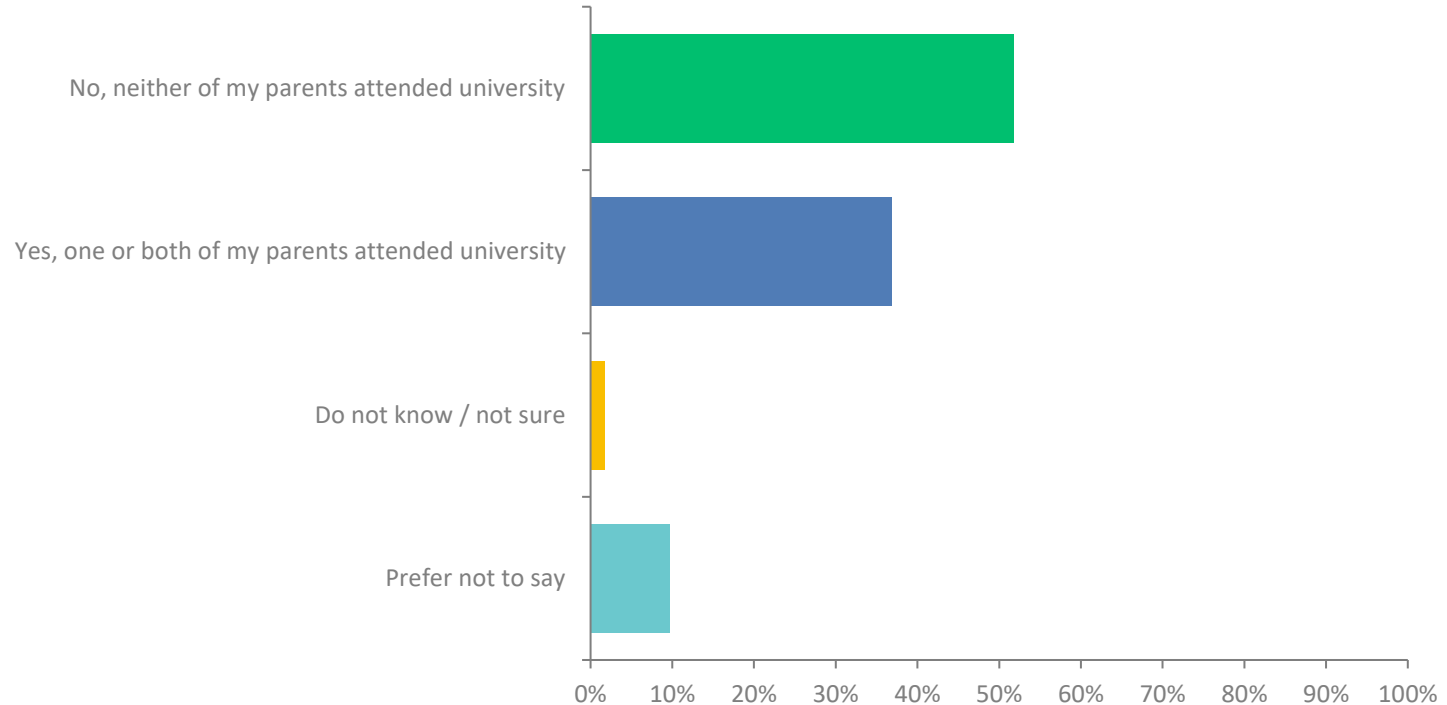

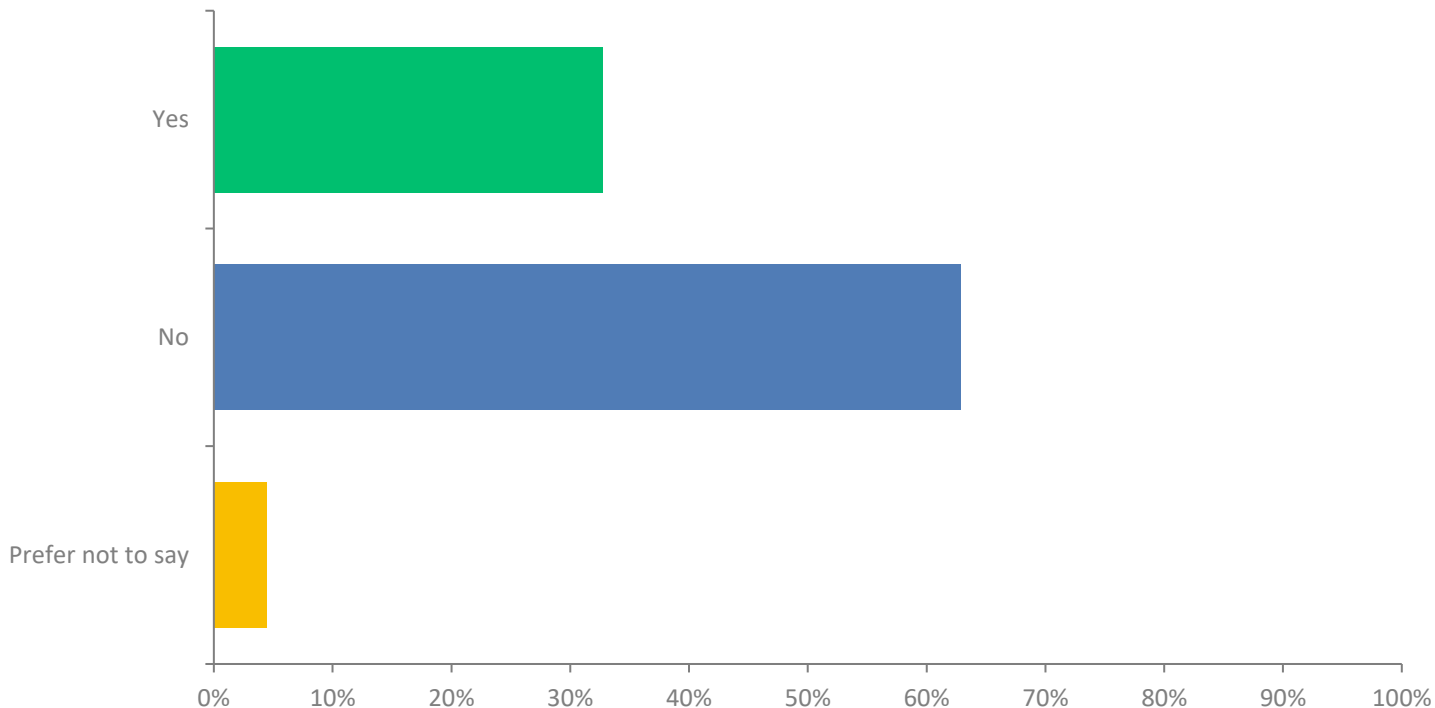
